More than 26,000 children with special challenges participate in the Challenger Division of Little League Baseball, Incorporated. The division, started in 1989, is a part of Little League Baseball, the world's largest organized youth sports program with nearly 2.7 million players.

SLL's Challenger Division is a baseball program for children and youth who have physical, developmental and intellectual disabilities (6 to 18 years of age). Our program provides these special kids with an opportunity to enjoy the full benefits of Little League participation at a level structured to their abilities. **More importantly, our program allows them to be part of a team and develop their social skills and build their self-esteem.** Players from our regular program act as "buddies" to assist the Challengers run the bases, catch, throw, push wheelchairs etc. Although our Challengers benefit from their assistance, the buddies are winners too as the enthusiasm and spirit the Challengers bring to the game is infectious.



Registration is open to all area kids, so you don't have to live in Sammamish to participate. The season runs from April to June with games being played on weekend afternoons with other teams from Redmond and Woodinville.
